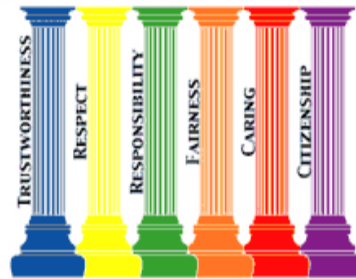


Services Provided by your School Counselor
