As part of this commitment we teach an internationally recognized program called *Second Step* in grades K,1,2,4,6,7, and 8. It is a program that aims at teaching children important prosocial skills such as empathy, problem solving and anger management.

Also included are such topics as bullying prevention and resistance to negative peer pressure.

Trained classroom teachers teach weekly lessons to all students that involve discussions, role playing and modeling positive interactions. Research has shown that students do better academically if they have effective social skills.
