Arrival & Dismissal Safety

As you pull in for arrival and dismissal, please remember to not leave too much space between your car and the one in front of it. This allows us to keep highway 24 safe and clear during these times. Also sedans and smaller SUVs, please stay right and use the lane closest to the sidewalk and curb.



During arrival all cars need to pull to the very front of the car rider line. If your car is behind the orange cone, go ahead and let your child out. If your car is behind the cone, please wait to pull up before letting your child out. This allows us to help make sure each child is safe before we release cars to move forward.

During pick up, we will wait until all kids are safely in their vehicles before we release each wave to leave. If you do not have your child before the line moves, please let the staff member at the front of the line know, then pull to the side of the cafeteria and park.

Clinic Corner with Nurse Betsy

All students must have updated immunizations and their school entry physical for PreK and Kindergarten as per the Code of Virginia. If you haven't already provided these to the clinic, please do so asap.

It's so good to be back at school and seeing all our children. We are in new times with health care and the COVID-19 virus. Please check your child daily for the following symptoms, fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, diarrhea, vomiting, headache, and loss of taste or smell.
