
Classroom Guidance

Students in grades K-4 have been exploring the "KELSO" Problem Solving curriculum. Kelso is a problem solving frog who teaches students about the difference between "big" problems that require adult assistance and small problems that children can try to solve. He offers them nine different approaches to problem solving. All fifth grade students will be challenged to learn a basic problem solving model in preparation for their move to the middle school. They will also practice applying this model to practical situations they could encounter.


