

New this year, CES is implementing a positive behavior support system. This PBS system fosters relationships and promotes positive reinforcement. Each student in grades K-5 received a CES Pride card that is attached to a lanyard during the first week of school. Students may wear these as they travel to lunch, resource, and other places on school campus. Students earn a star punch when they are caught making a good choice.

The completed CES pride cards can be redeemed for various items. Students may choose to save the card to redeem for a more "expensive" item. 

